#### DRESS CODE FOR TRYOUTS

All candidates must wear:

- Plain white polo styled shirt (no visible logo)
- Solid black shorts
- White socks
- White athletic or cheer shoes
- Hair must be up in a secure high ponytail out of the candidate's face. To insure uniformity; no hair bows, ribbons, or any other accessories will be allowed.
- Natural makeup: at the very least, pink or red toned lips, blush or highlighter, natural eye shadow, & mascara.
- No jewelry allowed.

#### **TRYOUT DAY**

#### Saturday, April 30, 2022 at Memorial Pathway Academy

#### 1pm-1:30pm: Warm up in designated area

We will provide you with the number that you will wear for tryouts. You are not allowed to switch numbers with another candidate.

1:30 - 4pm: Tryout Time

**These tryouts are closed to the public**. No parents or friends will be allowed in the building at any time during tryouts. No exceptions. Candidates do not leave until you are dismissed. Same rules will be applied to Mock tryouts.

Every attempt is made to hire judges that have not worked with students in the Garland area. However, with the hundreds of camps in the state of Texas, attended by thousands of cheerleaders and taught by hundreds of instructors, it may be possible at some time that a member of the judging panel may have had some contact with a candidate who is trying out. Professional judges with outstanding credentials and references will be hired for all tryouts. They will be instructed to judge the candidates based only on the mastery of the skills that they see demonstrated during the tryouts. Tryout results will not be challenged because of prior knowledge of judges and candidates.

#### **TABULATION OF SCORES**

Each judge will enter his/her scores into a scoring spreadsheet. The tabulation spreadsheet will automatically throw out the scores of the lowest and highest scoring judges. Results will be based on the average of the remaining three scores. A person not connected to the tryout will use a computer-generated formula to calculate scores district wide. Each candidate must score a minimum percentage of points in order to be placed on a cheerleading squad.

HS Junior Varsity – 40%

HS Varsity - 50%

#### **NOTIFICATION**

Final results for each school will be published on the GHS Cheer Tryout Canvas Page on Saturday evening, April 30th, 2022.

#### **REQUEST FOR SCORES**

If you would like a copy of your individual scores mailed to you, please bring a stamped, self-addressed envelope to the sponsor prior to the tryouts.

#### TRYOUT SEQUENCE OF EVENTS

The whole group of candidates will enter together and perform as a whole group to show the judges the material first.

#### **GROUP CHANT:**

Groups should consist of 3-4 candidates. They should enter the gym so that they end up standing in numeric order from left to right. (From the judge's viewpoint) There should be no tumbling or spirit during this time, only uniform walking. Once the nod has been given, the designated candidate should call for the group chant to begin. Upon completion, the candidates should wait for the nod of admin to exit.

#### **GROUP DANCE:**

Once the nod has been given, the school representative should start the music for the dance. Once this has been completed, the candidates should remain in their spots until they are told to leave.

#### **INDIVIDUAL ENTRANCE:**

Candidate number #1 should enter the gym and wait for notification from the admin that they are ready. After admin has nodded, the candidate should run in showing and soliciting spirit and enthusiasm doing whatever tumbling pass they wish if they are able. Once they are done with their entrance, they should stop in the center of the gym and wait for notification that the admin is ready for the next step. At this point, the judges will score the tumbling, spirit/enthusiasm, and the candidate's presence/poise. Presence/poise will include appearance with regard to the hair being out of the face, shirts tucked in if possible, shorts not being too short, proper shoes, facial expressions, etc.

#### **INDIVIDUAL JUMPS:**

Once the nod has been given, the candidate should do whatever jump they wish to do first and then wait for a nod before doing their second jump and then their third jump, giving the judges time to score each jump. Each high school candidate must perform a toe touch, a right hurdler, a left hurdler, and a jump of their choice. The jump of their choice can include, but is not limited to, a jump that they have already performed.

#### **INDIVIDUAL CHEER:**

Once the jumps have been completed and the nod has been given, the candidate should begin their cheer. The cheer will have a section(s) incorporating a jump(s) and/or tumbling. Candidates will be scored based on difficulty and execution. Candidates will also be judged on their smile, motion technique and voice projection during this time. Once the candidate has completed their cheer, they should exit the gym. No score will be given for an exit tumbling pass or spirit.

# 2022-2023 GHS Cheer Hair & Make Up Policy

GHS Cheerleading will have a set hair and make up policy to keep everyone in uniform. For the various activities' cheerleaders do, there will be different expectations for hair and make up. Presentation is an incredibly important part of enhancing a cheerleader's presence and building the atmosphere of a performance.

#### **Hair Expectations**

#### Practice

Varsity- Hair up and out of your face for safety purposes.

JV- Hair up and out of your face for safety purposes.

#### Games

Varsity- Various hair styles including: Half Up Half Down, High Pony, Low Pony (per Coach depending on the game). Bow needs to be facing forward and bobby pinned upright.

JV- High Pony unless the cheerleader has a short hair style that has hair falling above the shoulders in which they will do Half Up (per Coach depending on the game). Bow needs to be facing forward and bobby pinned upright.

#### **Parades**

Varsity- Half Up Half Down (per Coach depending on the parade). Bow needs to be facing forward and pinned.

JV- Half Up Half Down (per Coach depending on the parade). Bow needs to be facing forward and pinned.

#### Pep Rallies

Varsity- Various hair styles including: Half Up Half Down, High Pony, Low Pony (per Coach depending on the pep rally). Bow needs to be facing forward and pinned upright.

Homecoming- Coaches choice.

JV- Various hair styles including: Half Up Half Down, High Pony, Low Pony (per Coach depending on the pep rally). Bow needs to be facing forward and pinned upright.

Homecoming- Coaches choice.

#### Competition

Varsity- Various hair styles including: Half Up Half Down, High Pony, Low Pony (per Coach depending on the pep rally). Bow needs to be facing forward and pinned upright.

JV- Various hair styles including: Half Up Half Down, High Pony, Low Pony (per Coach depending on the pep rally). Bow needs to be facing forward and pinned upright.

\*\*\*Male Cheerleaders- styles and facial hair will be discussed with male cheerleader and coach on an as needed basis.

#### **Make Up Expectations**

#### Practice

Varsity- No formal make up needed for practices unless notified by Coach.

JV- No formal make up needed for practices unless notified by Coach.

#### Games

Varsity- At the very least, pink or red toned lips, blush or highlighter, natural eye shadow, & mascara. (Coach may add additional expectations such as pink glitter for Pink Out Game)

JV- At the very least, pink or red toned lips, blush or highlighter, natural eye shadow, & mascara. (Coach may add additional expectations such as pink glitter for Pink Out Game)

#### <u>Parades</u>

Varsity- At the very least, pink or red toned lips, blush or highlighter, natural eye shadow, & mascara.

#### Competition

Varsity- At the very least, pink or red toned lips, blush or highlighter, natural eye shadow, & mascara (Coach may add additional expectations)

JV- For the very least, pink or red toned lips, blush or highlighter, natural eye shadow, & mascara (Coach may add additional expectations).

\*\*\*\*All hair and make up expectations are subject to change with notice per Coach. The coach will inform all squad members of changes to planned expectations as soon as possible.\*\*\*\*

#### DISCLAIMER

"As a cheerleader, your child is covered by the school insurance, providing that the proper GISD channels are followed. However, you are encouraged to have your own insurance or to take the additional school."

#### **TRANSPORTATION**

Transportation changes depending on the year. Typically, we will bus to all football games together. Basketball and competition will be dependent on differing circumstances and will be determined at a later date.

#### **CHEERING ACTIVITIES**

In accordance with UIL rules, high school cheerleading squads are only permitted to cheer at one contest per school week. It would not be a violation for cheerleaders to cheer at a double header (two contests at the same site on one school night) or to participate in a pep rally prior to a contest and also lead cheers at the contest even though both occur during the school week. Friday night and weekend contests do not count toward the one contest per week rule.

#### CHEERLEADER COMPETITION

The expectation is that all cheerleaders will participate in competition. Failure to commit and participate in competition(s) will result in removal at semester. Tryouts may be held to determine competition groups etc. A separate handbook, approved by the campus principal, will be given to each competition member.

#### **PARADES**

Participation in the Martin Luther King Parade and Labor Day Parade is mandatory.

#### **FOOTBALL**

- A. Varsity cheerleaders will cheer at all varsity games.
- B. JV cheerleaders will cheer at all JV games at the sponsor's discretion. You may choose to cheer for the A or B team.
- C. JV cheerleaders may be asked to cheer at additional varsity games at the discretion of the campus.
- D. Freshmen games will be covered if there is a JV B squad.
- E. Playoff games will be covered.

#### **VOLLEYBALL**

- A. Games can be covered by any squad at the discretion of the campus administration and sponsor.
- B. Playoff games should be covered.

#### **BASKETBALL**

- A. All district varsity boys and girls games should be covered. Squad assignments will be at the discretion of the campus administration and the sponsor.
- B. If a campus has a JV B squad, they will be assigned either JV or freshmen games.
- C. Exceptions to the above rules are as follows:
  - a. No out of town games on Monday through Thursday nights.
  - b.No cheering during the holiday break.
- D. Playoff games should be covered.

#### OTHER ACTIVITIES

Additional activities such as community events, etc. will be at the discretion of the sponsor and the campus principal. Cheerleaders are required to attend each of these events.
