

➤ Who are the Gold Jackets?

Gold Jackets is the JV drill team at Garland High School. It is a team of energetic and fun performers who enjoy showing school spirit through dancing and performing throughout the year. It is open to any 9th -12th grade students. You do NOT need dance experience to join the fun!

➤ What do the Gold Jackets do?

- attend summer camp
- participate in the Garland Labor Day parade and the MLK Day Parade
- perform at half-time of district JV football games
- make spirit tunnels, dance, and cheer in the stands at Varsity football games
 - dance &/or attend all pep rallies
 - dance at JV basketball games
 - perform at special events
- perform at the District Fine Arts Dance and Drill Team Festival
 - learn dance & drill team technique
 - earn P.E. AND fine arts graduation credits
 - HAVE FUN!!

➤ What are the requirements for team members?

Gold Jackets begin meeting this summer to prepare for a fabulous year; all members must attend summer camp and practices. Once school begins, Gold Jackets attend a class that meets during school every other day (single blocked) fall and spring semesters. During the school year, there will be no more than one practice after school each week. All members are expected to maintain passing grades, honorable behavior, and good attendance. Gold Jackets must follow the district handbook outlining regulations for all JV drill teams and the director's rules. Please carefully review the JV drill team handbook. ➤ How do I join the team?

Complete the attached line member application and return to Mrs. Thomas, Gold Jackets director, by Tuesday, May 17, 2022. Attend uniform fittings on Tuesday, May 17, 2022 at 6:30pm in the GHS cafeteria and complete the required order form and payment #1.

➤ Would you like to be an officer?

They are responsible for leading warm-ups, remembering routines, motivating the team, and supporting the director and the Gold Jackets. They participate in extra activities such as officer leadership training and occasional practices. If you are interested in trying out to be a Gold Jacket officer, please refer to the officer section at the back of this packet.

Officers are selected through a tryout process. Candidates will learn all required routines during workouts May 9th- May 12th. Tryouts will be Thursday, May 12th. Solo dances are not required. The candidates will learn a jazz dance and officer strut. No spectators are allowed; results will be announced shortly after the conclusion of tryouts. Officers are the leaders of the Gold Jackets. They should always set a good example for the team.

*All Gold Jackets will be required to have black leggings, a solid black t-shirt or tank top, white "ked" like tennis shoes and a clear rain poncho. These items can be purchased anywhere and will be required by camp on July 28th.

*There will be a \$50 Spring semester fee due in January. This fee includes choreography, costumes, and props for basketball season and spring show. This also will include dance shoes that the students will be able to keep.

*We will wear our hair in a bun for football season, half up for basketball season, and in a bun for spring show. Your hair must be a natural color. We will wear skin colored tights for football season and spring show and you will choose them for yourself from Team Leader. Each member is allowed to wear her own make-up, but we wear red/plum lipstick for football season and plum lipstick for spring show. Piercings should be covered in practice, and removed for ALL performances. Tattoos should be covered with a bandaid during practice and makeup during performances.

*Uniforms must be washed on cold and hung to dry before returning uniform.

Officer Tryouts

1. Officer workouts: May 9th-11th (Monday – Wednesday), 4:30-6:00pm, GHS Girls Gym Officer candidates may wear any dance attire during the week of workouts.
2. Officer tryouts: May 12th (Thursday), 4:30 pm, Garland High School, Girls Gym Results will be announced approximately 30 minutes after the conclusion of tryouts.
3. Candidates will be judged according to the following criteria:
Application (grades, questionnaire, recommendations) – 30 pts
Timing/Style – 10 pts
Jazz Dance – 20pts
Officer Strut – 15 pts
Right Leg Splits – 5 pts
Interview – 20 pts
4. The jazz dance and officer strut will be taught during officer workouts. The only requirement to be completed before tryouts is the officer application. No solo routine is required.
5. All officer candidates are required to wear the attire listed below for tryouts.
Solid black top or leotard
Black leggings or jazz pants
Any dance shoes or tennis shoes (whatever you're comfortable with) Hair in ponytail
6. Officer application is due to Mrs. Thomas, Gold Jackets Director, on/by Monday, May 9th.
