Mandatory Parts to the Sign Up protocol for Guaranteed Membership to the Lariats Failure to correctly execute any of the below requirements eliminates students from Lariat Team membership for the 23-24 school year.

Part 1: Mandatory Information Meeting: Must attend the mandatory information meeting in person with a guardian or parent.

Part 2: Mandatory Lariat Workshop: Must attend and fully participate every day. Students will learn the "Lariat Workshop Dance Routine". This routine may be used for Lariat performances in the future.

Part 3: Mandatory Lariat Show Offs: Must attend and perform the "Lariat Workshop Dance Routine" on final day of workshop. Families will be invited to Show Offs.

Part 4: Mandatory Submission of Team Size Sheet: Immediately following Show Offs, dancers will submit the Team Size Sheet. Dancers did try on samples of the mandatory Team Clothing Items during workshop week. These items will will be used in the upcoming seasons.
Mandatory Payments: Must be made on time. Payment #1 (half of total bill) will be made immediately following show offs. The remaining balance may be divided into two payments.

Paperwork: Due by the third day of the workshop. Any missing paperwork excludes you from membership. You will be asked to leave the workshop and not participate. It is not your Director;s responsibility to ask for the paperwork. No exceptions!

Physical: Must be submitted on or before the deadline. Failure to do so, will result in the student unable to physically participate.

Page 1 signed by parent/ guardian and is due on Workshop day #1. Page 2 signed by physician, is due by the last day of school.

Media Page: In order to be included in photos and videos throughout the year, select first options please.

Canvas: must join the Lariat canvas classroom and learn material posted in Canvas by due dates.

Football Season

Lariats will perform at some Sachse JV/ Freshman games and attend three Varsity Games. The Lariats will be required to attend some early morning practices with the Swingsters to work on field spacing for both teams. The weeks that the Lariat attend Varsity games will be tough. There will be a game Thursday night and Friday night.

Mandatory Parade/Community Service

Labor Day, HOCO, SHS Christmas, and MLK Day parade, Santa Ambassadors, GISD Black History Month Program, and community events.

Contest Season

Lariats will perform three or four team dances at the GISD Dance Festival and one or two Regional Competition during February and March. Failure to participate equals drop in the program. Students pay for their contest meals.

Spring Show

Lariats will perform up to four team dances in the Swingsters Spring Show. Lariat Officers perform as well. Lariats will be invited to sit in the audience to observe stage practice.



Lariats: A Year in Review

Team Mandatory Information Meeting: Face to Face meeting mandatory for guaranteed membership with the sign up JV Lariat program. Failing to attend results in no membership on the team.

Mandatory Lariat Workshop/Team Fitting: Dancers attend all 4 days of the workshop to learn the Lariat routine. One the final day, the dancers perform for family/ friends. Failing to attend results in no membership on the team. Dancers will try on sample team clothing items so that the Director can note the preferred sizes.

Communication: Weekly announcements are posted on the team canvas page. Parents must join the team canvas page.

Payment 1 and submission of Size Sheet:

This will take place immediately following the show offs. Each family will receive the noted sizes for each dancer. Failure to participate results in no membership on the team. $\frac{1}{2}$ of the total team payment is due at the team fitting.

May and Summer Practices and Camp: Practices and summer camp are mandatory. Camp= bonding, skills, technique, Pep Rally dances, Football dances, entrance and exit to the field will be learned. Unapproved absences= being pulled from formations.

Class Period/After School Practice: Mandatory: B8 both semesters plus 45 minutes after school. Dismissed at 3:30pm on B Days. On A Days, the team will have practice from 3:15pm-5:15pm. Secure your travel arrangements. No after school practices on Fridays.

Football Season: Football games are mandatory. The Lariats perform at some JV football games and participate in pre game/ bleacher dances at 3 Varsity games. Dancers audition for halftimes and Pre Game. If buses are provided, the team travels on the GISD provided transportation.

Parades/Community Events: The Lariats may participate in four parades throughout the Fall and Spring including Labor Day, HOCO, Sachse Christmas and the MLK Day parades as well as community events. Preparation for Varsity Tryouts.

Competition Season: Lariats will attend the GISD Dance Festival and one or two Regional competitions during Feb and March. Dancers audition for all contest dances. There is no extra cost associated with contest season. Students pay for their meals on contest day. Competition dates will be provided once they are available. Lariats come before Studio.

Spring Show: Lariats perform in the Swingsters Spring Show in April. The Spring Show is held in the SHS Auditorium. Because this is a Varsity end of the year show, Lariat families will be invited to purchase tickets once the Swingsters have had the opportunity to purchase tickets.

Banquet: Dressy casual event with a possible meal to celebrate the team's accomplishment with Lariats and family. Parents, please be mindful that this is a school function. All GISD policies will be in play for both students and adults. School dress code is enforced.



Practice Etiquette: Demerits Apply

You are seeking membership for an award winning JV Drill Team. Lariats will function like a competition drill team at a 6A school not a pep squad. You will be coached with love, but you will be coached hard.

You will have your name called out loud. Admin. calls out teachers over the speaker system used for school announcements when teachers are late to duty.

*Lariats is designed to prepare you for Swingsters. Learn the Sachse Way.

*Always respond to instructions including verbal and body language. This allows the director to know you heard and understand.

*Approach practice/performances in a professional manner, let's not interrupt the instructional environment.

*Practice on your own weekly!

*Do NOT talk during instruction.

*Hustle in practice.

*Get dressed in a timely manner for class/practice.

*Accept critiques. Keep your eyes and ears open.

*Seek help. Be available to attend extra practices to better yourself.

*Take care of our Lariat Locker Room Space.

*Take care of your Lariat uniform and items. See Uniform page.

*Please be respectful and kind.

*Absolutely no food or drink other than water in the locker room.

*To maximize time, dance full out unless told otherwise.

*To maximize time, students follow directions quickly and correctly.

*Students adhere to the time frame provided for gathering belongings following performances.

*Students exit the locker room in full uniform following performances.



Standard of Uniformity: Demerits Apply

Students arrive completely ready. We do not apply make up, paint nails nude or fix hair in squad lines.

Low Ponytail at the nape of the neck, with center part. Lariats will not be let out of class to prepare hair for the performance. Hair may be wavy, braided, curled, straight etc... as long as it is a clean sleek look.

Pep Rally, Contest, Special Performances and Spring Show Performance Hair

Low Ponytail at the nape of the neck, with center part. Lariats will not be let out of class to prepare hair for the performance.

Tights:

Tights are to be clean and run free.

Make up:

Black eyeliner Black mascara Blush that matches your skin tone Eye Shadow in shades of browns, golds, peaches that match your skin tone Revlon "Love That RED" lipstick. Do NOT add gloss or glitter.

Nails:

Students will arrive at school on performance day with nails done to avoid demerits. <u>During Performance Seasons:</u> Shades of solid light pinks Shades solid nudes French manicure with white tip No sparkle or decal of any kind on nails Sports length per GISD drill team handbook.

Food:

Lariats eat prior to meeting for uniform inspection. Do not bring food to inspection! Budget your time please.

Procedures for Sachse Lariat Drill Team Workshop:

May 2-4	Workshop in Sachse Cafeteria to learn tryout material/ body movement from 4:15pm-6pm.
May 4	Deadline for Tryout Paperwork to be submitted into Canvas Classroom No Exceptions. Problems submitting, contact Ms. Craig at <u>dcraig@garlandisd.net</u> . Do not wait until the last minute.
May 4	Perform workshop routine for family/ friends. Arrive at Sachse small gym dressed and ready to go for check in at 4-6pm . New team meeting/showoffs at 6-8 p.m. in cafeteria
May 5	Lariat Officer tryouts. Details coming.
Eligibility:	Incoming Freshman, Sophomore, Junior or Senior students enrolled at Sachse High for the 2023-2024 school year at the time of tryouts for the 2023-2024 school year. Transfer guidelines must be followed for GISD. Confirmation of SHS acceptance is required.

Overall Impression: We get one chance to make a first impression! Be mindful of your posture, stance and appearance.

Attire for Workshop: All Black Athletic/ Dance Attire.

*Solid black form fitted dance top, form fitted athletic top or leotard.

*Sports bras (black) should be worn. No bra straps or stomachs showing!

*Black dance pants, leggings or shorts. (shorts should be appropriate length)

*Loose fitting dance pants should not be worn unless you have no other options.

*Footwear: barefoot, jazz shoes in any color or half soles in any color.

*Hair at workshop: secure your hair in Lariat performance hair. *See uniformity page*

Performance Day: All Black Athletic/ Dance Attire.

*Attire: Same as workshop practices

*Hair on performance day: Performance hair

*Gum and jewelry will not be allowed during practice or the audition.

*Nails must be a neutral color and modest length

*"Performance makeup"mascara, eyeliner & lipstick for your skin tone.

Page 2, signed by the Doctor is due by last day of school. Can NOT participate/dance until this form is submitted. The first page with parent signature must be submitted before the Workshop, the second page by the doctor must be submitted by the last day of school

Uniform Contract

The Lariat uniform has been bought and issued by GISD and shall be returned in the similar condition it was received. The Director will evaluate uniforms upon return/check in. Dancers are financially obligated for damages to the uniform:

Hanging up of the Uniform

It will be in the closet at home OR hanging in the drill team locker, not on the locker room floor. Swingsters hang up the uniform, we do not throw pieces over the hanger. We do not use wire hangers.

Shirt: hang on hanger. Avoid pointy shoulders. Skirt/ bloomers: pants/ skirt hanger

Gauntlets: on pants/ skirt hangerSleeves: hang on hanger. Avoid pointy shoulders.Belt: metal loop over hanger, string tiedOverlay: hang on hanger neck opening over hanger

Care of the Uniform

Prior to each performance, trim unraveled threads, stitch any holes and tack down any loose sequins before each performance. Feel free to ask Ms. Craig to help you, she can sew!

Cleaning Fees: \$5 per uniform item may be charged to cover professional cleaning costs.

*Frequent cleaning is a must. *No part of the uniform should be dry cleaned!

*Do not use bleach. *Please take precautions so that the colors do not run.

*Shorts/ bloomers/ leo may be washed on the delicate cycle.

*All pieces should each be cleaned individually by placing the item in a sink or tub of very cold water that has a capful of wool-lite or very delicate soap. Swish the item through water several times. It is best not to leave the item in the water. Dry the items hanging on a hanger or lay the item on a flat surface.

Uniform Check-In

Will be conducted once at the conclusion of football season and again at the conclusion of spring show.

It is strongly encouraged that a parent/guardian help the team member take care of the school uniform. Remember each dancer is financially responsible for any damages to the uniform she was issued.
