SAPPHIRES TRYOUT INFORMATION AND GUIDELINES

The purpose of drill team is to:

- a. Promote school spirit, sportsmanship, pride, and loyalty.
- b. Promote interest in school activities and perform at games.
- c. Develop responsibility and character, teach self-discipline and self-respect, encourage honest effort, strive for excellence and develop a close bond with their teammates.
- d. Teach teamwork and pride through a quality performance by maintaining high standards.

Participation in the drill team, as well as any extra-curricular activity is a **privilege** and <u>not a right</u>, and the student must meet specific requirements to be selected and to participate.

FREE DANCE PREP CLASS (Before Tryouts—recommended, but not required)

*6 free dance classes will be taught by the Director to help prepare candidates for tryouts.

*Join in person (SGHS dance studio), dress out into dance clothes, and be ready to start at 4:30pm. The free dance clinic will be 1 hour long to assist you with stretching, kick and dance technique.

TRYOUTS DAY & JUDGING CRITERIA

Sapphires Junior Varsity Drill Team

Tryouts will be held on **Saturday, April 27, 2024** at Naaman Forest High School inside the Main Gym.

More details regarding tryouts will be provided at the mandatory parent/student meeting and during the week of tryouts (arrival time, where to enter for roll call, etc.). <u>Parents are not allowed to stay for tryouts</u>.

WHAT TO WEAR FOR TRYOUTS:

*Black fitted tank top, fitted T-shirt, or fitted Long-sleeve. (No spaghetti straps, crop tops or low cuts showing your chest).

*Black long leggings for females, black fitted sweatpants for males. (Make sure your leggings are not see-through, wear appropriate undergarments underneath in case they are thin material).

*Lightweight tennis shoes, nude dance slippers, black/nude jazz shoes (if you already have a pair)

*Middle part, Low ponytail (slick back): ponytail hair can be straight or curly, make sure your hair is neat & presentable

*Make-up for females: silver/black eye shadow, mascara, blush/bronzer, RED lipstick

Auditions are closed. No one may be in the warm-up area with the candidates. Callbacks are a possibility. You may not leave until you are dismissed. Make sure the holding area is left clean.

JUDGES/SCORING

The judges are from a variety of major drill team companies. All judges will be certified and experienced in the field of drill team and adjudication. There will be 5 judges. The high and low total score will be dropped and the middle 3 will be added together for the final composite score. The director's score will be factored into the final tryout score.

"TRYOUT TIPS"

- 1. Have a clean black tank top (2-3 inch straps), fitted black T-shirt or long-sleeve top, one pair of fitted black long leggings "solid black" (Walmart, Target, etc.) and nude dance slippers, black/nude jazz shoes, or lightweight tennis shoes. (They do not have to be brand new, just without holes or tears.)
- 2. Style your hair with a middle part, low ponytail slicked back (straight). Please wear enough hair bands and bobby pins so that your hair will stay secure as you dance.
- 3. Don't overdo your make-up! This is always one of the first mistakes that a drill team candidate makes. Be sure to wear make-up but do not let it be an overpowering part of your appearance. Loose glitter is not allowed!
- 4. Each hopeful will need to wear RED lipstick for try-outs. Any lipstick brand will be fine for auditions. Just make sure it is RED, not maroon, brown or pink.
- 5. Stay focused and have a positive attitude.

Do your very best and convince the judges through your smile and performance how much you really want to be a Sapphire. <u>WE are looking for potential</u>, so do your best to shine!!!

EXPECTATIONS for all SAPPHIRES

* Always say, "Yes Ma'am/Yes Sir" when corrected or given directions by anyone! We all practice <u>mutual respect</u> and <u>good manners</u> inside and outside of practice!

* Make payments on time, and/or communicate with the director ahead of time to request an extension. Anyone who does not make their payment on time, will not receive their ordered items, and will not be allowed to perform.

- * Turn in paperwork/forms, costumes, props, etc., in on time. (Strive to be early and never late.)
- * Be on time for <u>all</u> rehearsals and performances.
- * Wear the correct attire for <u>all</u> rehearsal and performances.
- * Always look presentable inside and outside of school. (Following school policy for dress code)
- * Put your name on everything that is yours!!!!! It is imperative that you label your items!

* Show respect towards the director's decisions, instructions, practice goals, etc. (Do not speak negatively about decisions made, etc.), instead go speak with your director after practice.

- * Chewing gum, and wearing jewelry during practice is inappropriate and unacceptable.
- * Wear **RED** lipstick for every performance unless told that you don't have to.
- * Keep the dressing room neat and clean at all times!!!
- * No eating allowed inside the locker room or dance studio! (Unless given permission by director)
- * Keep all valuables locked up in your locker. (This includes money, jewelry, etc.)

* <u>School attendance is very important</u>. You may not miss school, unless it's a medical emergency, death in the family, or absolutely unavoidable!

- * **<u>NEVER</u> talk back or respond inappropriately.** Be kind and respectful to all, at all times!
- * Only talk positively about our organization and your fellow team-mates.

* Be a role model...set a good example for the <u>Sapphires</u> and yourself at all times. Always behave/speak like a lady/gentleman (inside and outside of school). You represent the Sapphires!

- * Follow the rules and regulations at all times! Garland ISD policies, South Garland HS policies, and Sapphires expectations.
- * If any problem occurs, go to the Directors or a dance officer for help and advice immediately.
- * Avoid receiving demerits for <u>anything</u> (inappropriate behavior, forgetting items, arriving late, etc.)
- * You must have appropriate and clean "social media" accounts at all times, otherwise consequences will be assigned!

Sapphires Seasons: "A Year in Review"

Team Fitting:

The Director will set a date for "Team Fitting" to help all Sapphires get fitted for practice & performance items. The Director will use samples from vendors to complete their order form.

Summer Practices and Camp:

All members must attend all summer practices scheduled by the director. Members are required to attend summer camp where they will bond as a team, get to know each other, but also dedicate time to develop their skills needed for the school year. Football Game-Day preparations, Football Routines, Pep Rally Routines and other material will be learned during summer practices and camp.

Officer/Social Leadership Clinic:

One day clinic held for candidates that make a dance officer/social officer position. They will learn additional skills to help them be successful leaders throughout the year.

Class Period:

Sapphires JV drill class is single blocked for both semesters.

Weekly Practice Schedule:

As a member of the Sapphires, you will be required to attend all after school practices from 3pm to 5pm. Students will receive a calendar at the beginning of the school year so they can plan accordingly. Each unexcused absence will result in demerits based on the GISD Fine Arts Handbook, and possible removal from upcoming performances.

Football Season:

The Sapphires will be required to attend 3-5 <u>District Junior Varsity</u> football games as designated by the director. These are scheduled on either Wednesday or Thursday evenings during the fall semester. Attendance at JV football games is mandatory. You must ride the school bus with the team to each game location, and you must have someone to pick you up upon arrival at SGHS following the game. During football season all members will learn all routines and must audition for each routine.

The Sapphires must attend a minimum of 3 HOME District Varsity football games as designated by the director. These are scheduled on either Thursday or Friday evenings during the fall semester, and usually fall on the day after the JV football games. Attendance and transportation are the same as JV football games unless notified of change.

Parades/Community Events:

The Sapphires participate in 2 parades throughout the year; Labor Day Parade (Sept. 2, 2024) and MLK Parade (Jan. 18, 2025). Members will also participate in community events (during school and afterschool).

Basketball Season:

The Sapphires attend to support and perform at home basketball games. Dates are determined when the Basketball schedule is provided to the director.

GISD Dance Festival:

At this event all GISD Dance/Drill Teams will showcase various routines. The festival is open to the public for spectators to attend.

Varsity Spring Show

The Sapphires will perform in the Royal Legacy end of the year drill team production held in the SGHS Auditorium.

End of the Year Banquet:

At this event the Sapphires celebrate their accomplishments from the year.

Uniform Return:

All members of the JV Drill Team will receive clean district uniforms for the school year, and will be required to return all uniform pieces dry-cleaned, or pay an estimated cost of \$10-\$15 for the cleaning fee.

Fundraisers

Fundraisers are held throughout the year to help raise money for team needs. Fundraisers will be discussed in more detail at each Booster Club meeting.

*Sapphires is a year-round commitment with a <u>1-month summer break</u>, plus holiday breaks throughout the school year! *We also plan <u>Team Bonding Activities</u> for our team to unite, relax and make fun memories together!
