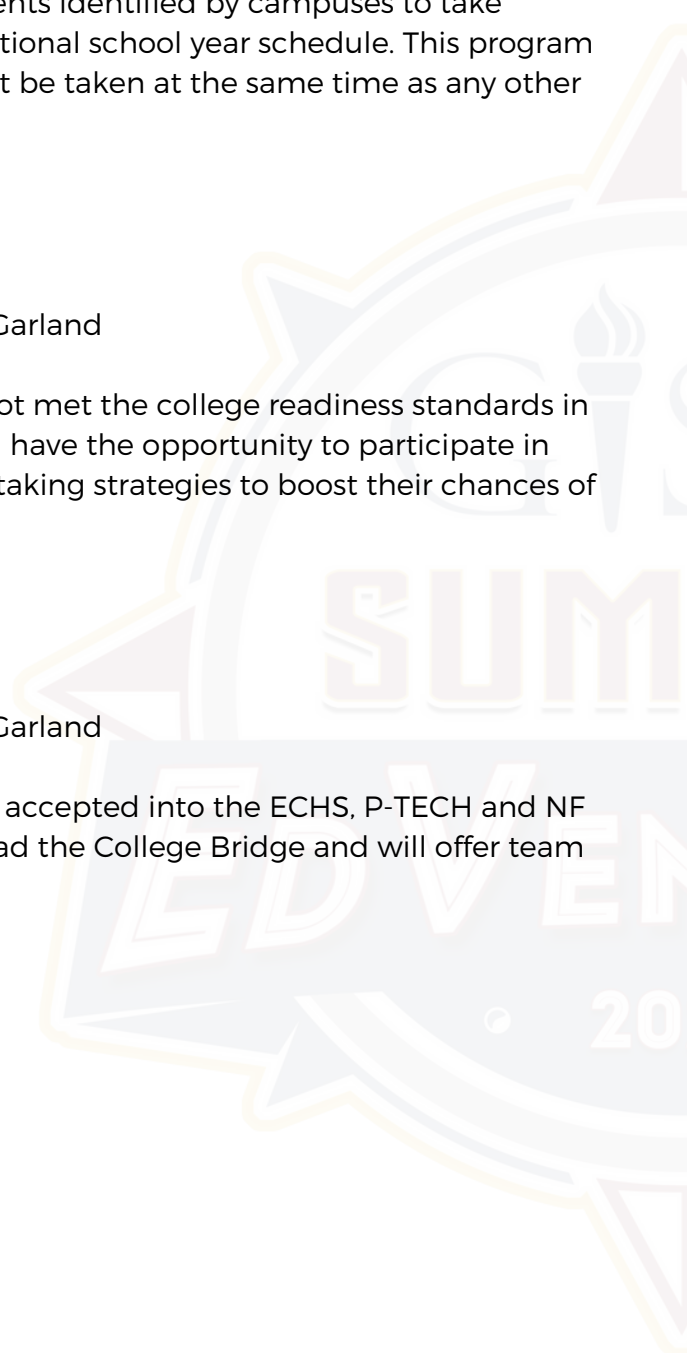
College Bridge

Crocheting Design & Basket Weaving (Grades 3-5): Students will create projects using patterns by crocheting. Students will advance based on their skills and abilities.

The Artful Scientist (Grades 3-5): Each day will focus on a different sense. The students will read about and practice using each sense with a hands-on activity. This course is geared towards early elementary learners.

Self-Expression using Digital Tools (Grades 3-5): CANVA gives students the flexibility to express themselves through digital tools. Through digital tools, students can take responsibility for their learning, and their content, and can express themselves in ways that sometimes they can't with words.

Social and Emotional Learning Lessons (SEL) (Grades 3-5): Students develop skills for life through understanding and regulating their emotions while creating fun and meaningful arts and crafts.

Family and Friends (Grades 1 & 2): Each day the arts and craft activity will build on the theme of friends, family and being together.

Music Enrichment (Grades 3-5): Students will explore concepts like rhythm, meter, tempo, lyrics, rhyme, and melody and create rhythmic, melodic, and lyrical phrases through composition. 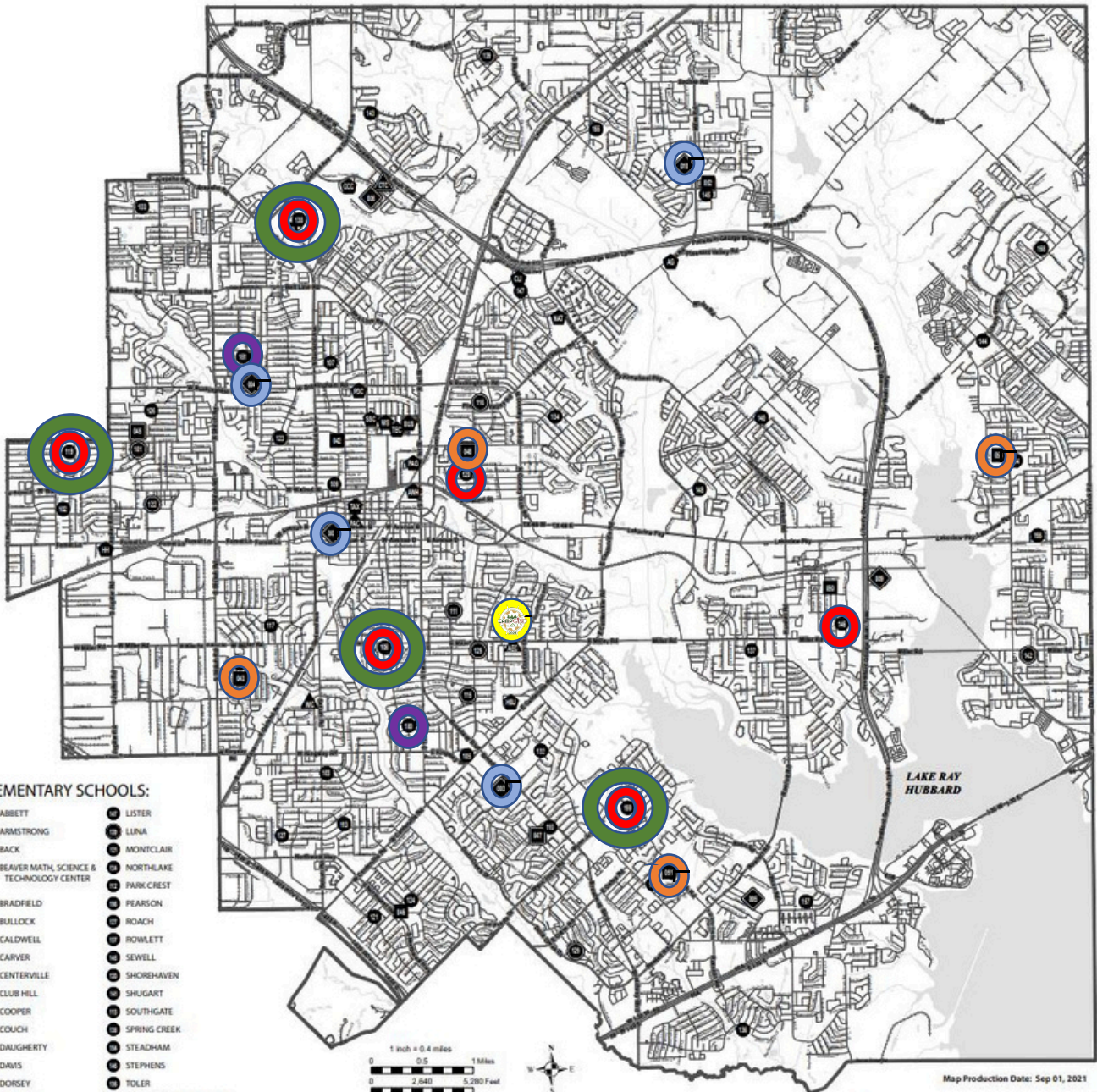
