TRYOUTS & JUDGING CRITERIA

- ★ Mandatory Tryout Clinic:
 - Tuesday, April, 22nd through Friday, April 25th
 - 4-6pm @ NFHS (Main Gym)
- ★ Mandatory Mock Tryouts:
 - Friday, April 25th
 - 4-6pm @ NFHS (Main Gym)
- ★ Tryout Day:
 - Saturday, April 26th
 - 12:30pm @ Lakeview Centennial High School

Tryout clinics will be held after school from 4-6pm in the NFHS gym starting on Tuesday, April 22nd through Friday, April 25th. All candidates must be present at these practices. Mock tryouts will be on April 25th from 4-6pm.

During these practices, the graduating officers will teach a jazz/kick dance combination to be performed for the judges on April 26th. All candidates should wear dance clothes for all practices. Supportive sports bra, appropriate undergarments, black OR tan jazz shoes, or half soles should be worn. No crocs, slides or sock feet. Leggings and shorts are permitted.

The tryout date for the 2025-2026 Drill Team at Naaman Forest High School will be <u>Saturday, April 26,</u> <u>2025.</u> More details regarding tryouts will be provided at the mandatory parent tryout information meeting and during the week of tryouts (arrival time, where to enter for roll call, etc.)

Tryouts will be closed to all spectators. Each candidate must stay until the end of tryouts in order to allow for judging callbacks as needed if deemed necessary.

There is <u>not</u> a "set" number of team members. The team will be determined by the candidate's score. All dancers are required to come to the tryout clinic, and required to try out in order to be selected for the team. If a candidate scores below all minimum scores they are strongly recommended to be placed in the Dance class for the school year.

If your dancer is selected for the team, they must abide by rules outlined by the GISD Fine Arts Handbook. The rules are constructed to uphold fairness and consistency in all aspects of drill team across the district. Each candidate and parent must read and discuss, at length, as well as agree to abide.

JUDGES/SCORING

- ★ Each candidate will be scored on a 100 point scale by three or more qualified judges from outside GISD.
- \star Selection of team members will be based on their scores in the following categories:
 - 1. Jazz combination
 - 2. Kick combination
 - 3. Splits (Right & Left)
 - **The director's score will be factored into the final tryout score**

"TRYOUT TIPS"

- 1. Have a clean black tank top (no spaghetti straps), fitted black T-shirt or long-sleeve top, black long leggings and black/nude jazz shoes, or dance slippers.
- 2. Style your hair with a middle part, low ponytail slicked back. Please wear enough hair bands and bobby pins so that your hair will stay secure as you dance.
- 3. Don't overdo your make-up! This is always one of the first mistakes that a drill team candidate makes. Be sure to wear make-up but do not let it be an overpowering part of your appearance.
- 4. Each hopeful will need to wear RED lipstick for try-outs. Any lipstick brand will be fine for auditions. Just make sure it is RED.
- 5. Stay focused and have a positive attitude.

Do your very best and convince the judges through your smile and performance how much you really want to be a Starlette. <u>They are looking for potential, so do your best to shine!!!</u>

<u>Starlettes Seasons</u>: "A Year in Review"

Team Fitting:

The Director will set a date for "Team Fitting" to help all Starlettes get fitted for practice & performance items.

Summer Practices and Camp:

All members must attend all summer practices scheduled by the director. Members are required to attend summer camp where they will bond as a team, get to know each other, but also dedicate time to develop their skills needed for the school year. Football Game-Day preparations, Football Routines, Pep Rally Routines and other material will be learned during summer practices and camp.

Officer/Social Leadership Clinic:

Clinic held for candidates that make a dance officer/social officer position. They will learn additional skills to help them be successful leaders throughout the year.

Class Period:

JV drill class is single blocked for both semesters.

Weekly Practice Schedule:

You will be required to attend all after school practices from 3-5pm. Practices are typically twice a week. Students will receive a calendar at the beginning of the school year so they can plan accordingly. Each unexcused absence will result in demerits based on the GISD Fine Arts Handbook, and possible removal from upcoming performances.

Football Season:

The Starlettes will be required to attend 3-5 <u>District Junior Varsity</u> football games as designated by the director. These are scheduled on either Wednesday or Thursday evenings during the fall semester. Attendance at JV football games is mandatory. You must ride the school bus with the team to each game location, and you must have someone to pick you up upon arrival at NFHS following the game. During football season all members must audition for each routine.

The Starlettes must attend a minimum of 3 HOME District Varsity football games as designated by the director. These are scheduled on either Thursday or Friday evenings during the fall semester, and usually fall on the day after the JV football games. Attendance and transportation are the same as JV football games unless notified of change.

Parades/Community Events:

The Starlettes participate in 2 parades throughout the year; Labor Day Parade (September 1, 2025) and MLK Parade (January 17, 2026). Members will also participate in community events (during school and afterschool).

Basketball Season:

The Starlettes attend to support and perform at home basketball games. Dates are determined when the basketball schedule is provided to the director.

GISD Dance Festival:

At this event all GISD Dance/Drill Teams will showcase various routines. The festival is open to the public for spectators to attend.

Varsity Spring Show

The Starlettes will perform in the Sterling Stars end of the year drill team production.

Uniform Return:

All members of the JV Drill Team will receive clean district uniforms for the school year, and will be required to return all uniform pieces dry-cleaned, or pay an estimated cost of **\$25** for the cleaning fee.

Fundraisers

Fundraisers may be held throughout the year to help raise money for team needs. Fundraisers will be discussed in more detail at each Booster Club meeting.

*Starlettes is <u>a year-round commitment</u> plus holiday breaks throughout the school year! *We also plan <u>Team Bonding Activities</u> for our team to unite, relax and make fun memories together!

Standards of Uniformity

Starlettes Junior Varsity Drill Team

In effort to assist dancers in abiding by all GISD Fine Arts Handbook guidelines a diverse committee of dancers, parents, and directors have determined team hair styles by season & performance type. It is the expectation that all dancers adhere to the required hairstyles to avoid demerits.

Football/Basketball Season: Low ponytail with middle part (extremely secured, no flyaways) Spring Show: Low ponytail with middle part (extremely secured, no flyaways) Special Appearances/Events: Half up/half down curly (extremely secured, no flyaways), and low ponytail with middle part (extremely secured, no flyaways)

**No eccentric, bright hair colors (ex:pink, blue, red, etc.) or extremely long hair (for safety). Hair length must be at a danceable length without causing a distraction or harm to self/others.

Make-up

Natural eyeshadow Mascara (black) Blush that matches your skin tone Red lipstick that matches your skin tone

<u>Nails</u>

Short/medium length only per handbook (for safety) Light shade of solid pinks or nudes, french manicure with white tip is allowed *No eccentric, bright shades, rhinestones, decal or prints

<u>Jewelry</u>

Drill team earrings will be worn for performances and events No personal jewelry (including face piercings) may be worn during practices or any drill team events

EYELASHES, TATTOOS & FACIAL PIERCINGS:

Eyelashes must be natural hair color (no colored eyelashes) Tattoos must be covered up for all practices and drill team events without damaging district uniforms (with the proper tattoo cover-up make-up)

Facial piercings must be removed during practices/drill team events, but may be worn during the school day

*Starlettes are required to wear their performance hair and make-up to school on pep-rally days. *Everyone must meet the nail, jewelry, eyelashes, tattoos, and facial piercing requirements at all times to avoid demerits. We have read and understand the Standards of Uniformity for Starlettes, and will abide by all expectations listed above. As the parent/legal guardian, I will support the expectations.

There will be opportunities throughout the year where you can purchase T-shirts and additional items

GISD provides the official field uniforms. All items that are issued to the member must be returned throughout the season. They must be cleaned according to specific care instructions before returning for safe storage. A cleaning fee of \$25 can be paid in place of cleaning the uniform on your own.

GISD Uniform Cleaning Guidelines

<u>All Field Uniforms</u>: HAND WASH ONLY! No bleach or color safe bleach. Gentle detergent, hand wash in the sink or bathtub. The handwash cycle on the washing machine may not be used.

- Turn water on and add minimum clear detergent. Once the detergent is dissolved completely , put the uniform pieces of similar color and style in the water.
- Gently agitate the items in the water and allow to soak until you feel it is clean and odor free. Repeat the agitation process if odor or stains remain.
- Drain the water and then add fresh water to rinse out ALL remaining detergent. Water should run clear and clean. Lay flat to dry or you may hang to dry. They will drip water. DO NOT put it in the dryer!!!!!

All uniforms and costumes must be cleaned properly and returned throughout the year as designated by the Director. Failure to do so will result in additional fees.
