Middle part, slicked back, low ponytail with curls (extremely secured no flyaways) with hair colored hair tie

****No eccentric or bright colored hair is allowed; nor hair jewelry/beads.**

****Hair length must be at a danceable length without causing a distraction or harm to self/others.**

MAKE-UP:

Eye Shadow (black and shiny silver)

Mascara (black)

Blush that matches your skin tone

Red lipstick that matches your skin tone

NAILS:

Sports length per GISD drill team handbook (for safety)

Light shade of solid pinks or nudes, french manicure with white tip is allowed

ROYAL LEGACY TRYOUT INFORMATION AND GUIDELINES

The purpose of drill team is to:

- a. Promote school spirit, sportsmanship, pride, and loyalty.
- b. Promote interest in school activities and perform at games.
- c. Develop responsibility and character, teach self-discipline and self-respect, encourage honest effort, strive for excellence and develop a close bond with their teammates.
- d. Teach teamwork and pride through a quality performance by maintaining high standards.

Participation in the drill team, as well as any extra-curricular activity is a **privilege** and **not a right**, and the student must meet specific requirements to be selected and to participate.

FREE DANCE PREP CLASS (Before Tryouts—recommended, but not required)

*4 free dance classes will be taught by the Director to help prepare candidates for tryouts.

*Join in person (SGHS gym), dress out into dance clothes, and be ready to start at 5pm. The free dance clinic will be 2 hours long to assist you with stretching, kick and dance technique.

TRYOUTS DAY & JUDGING CRITERIA

Royal Legacy Varsity Drill Team

Tryouts will be held on **Saturday, April 26, 2025** at Lakeview Centennial High School inside the Main Gym. More details regarding tryouts will be provided at the mandatory parent/student meeting and during the week of tryouts (arrival time, where to enter for roll call, etc.). Parents are **not** allowed to stay for tryouts.

WHAT TO WEAR FOR TRYOUTS:

***Black** fitted tank top, fitted T-shirt, or fitted Long-sleeve. (No spaghetti straps, crop tops or low cuts showing your chest).

*Black long leggings for females, black fitted sweatpants for males. (Make sure your leggings are not see-through, wear appropriate undergarments underneath in case they are thin material).

*Nude dance slippers, black/nude jazz shoes (if you already have a pair)

*Middle part, Low ponytail (slick back): ponytail hair can be straight or curly, make sure your hair is neat & presentable

*Make-up for females: silver/black eye shadow, mascara, blush/bronzer, RED lipstick

Auditions are closed. No one may be in the warm-up area with the candidates. Callbacks are a possibility. You may not leave until you are dismissed. Make sure the holding area is left clean.

JUDGES/SCORING

The judges are from a variety of major drill team companies. All judges will be certified and experienced in the field of drill team and adjudication. There will be 5 judges. The high and low total score will be dropped and the middle 3 will be added together for the final composite score. Each candidate must score a minimum of 75 out of a possible 100 points in order to be placed on a Varsity drill team at GISD. Candidates will be scored in the following categories: jazz routine, kick routine, splits, and director evaluation. The director's score will be factored into the final tryout score.

“TRYOUT TIPS”

1. Have a clean black tank top (2-3 inch straps), fitted black T-shirt or long-sleeve top, one pair of fitted black long leggings “solid black” (Walmart, Target, etc.) and nude dance slippers, or lightweight tennis shoes. (They do not have to be brand new, just without holes or tears.)
2. Style your hair with a middle part, low ponytail slicked back (straight). Please wear enough hair bands and bobby pins so that your hair will stay secure as you dance.
3. Don’t overdo your make-up! This is always one of the first mistakes that a drill team candidate makes. Be sure to wear make-up but do not let it be an overpowering part of your appearance. Loose glitter is not allowed!
4. Each hopeful will need to wear RED lipstick for try-outs. Any lipstick brand will be fine for auditions. Just make sure it is RED, not maroon, brown or pink.
5. Be ready for callbacks in case the judges need to see anyone a second time. Stay stretched and focused.
6. Remember the 3 P’s during try-outs:

PROJECTION

PERFECTION

PRECISION

Do your very best and convince the judges through your smile and performance how much you really want to be a Royal Legacy. WE are looking for potential, so do your best to shine!!!

WHAT TO WEAR FOR AUDITIONS

1. Black Fitted Tank Top (2-3 inch strap), Black Fitted T-shirt, Black Fitted Long-sleeve
2. Black Long Leggings (females), Black Fitted Sweatpants (Males)
3. Middle Part, low ponytail (slicked back, straight hair)
4. Black socks only
5. Nude Dance Slippers, Black or Nude Jazz Shoes, Lightweight tennis shoes
6. RED lipstick, silver/black eye shadow, blush/bronzer, mascara

EXPECTATIONS for all ROYAL LEGACIES

- * Always say, "Yes Ma'am/Yes Sir" when corrected or given directions by anyone! We all practice mutual respect and good manners inside and outside of practice!
- * ***Make payments on time, and/or communicate with the director ahead of time to request an extension. Anyone who does not make their payment on time, will not receive their ordered items, and will not be allowed to perform.***
- * Turn in paperwork/forms, costumes, props, etc., in on time. (Strive to be early and never late.)
- * Be on time for all rehearsals and performances.
- * Wear the correct attire for all rehearsal and performances.
- * Always look presentable inside and outside of school. (Following school policy for dress code)
- * Put your name on everything that is yours!!!! It is imperative that you label your items!
- * Show respect towards the director's decisions, instructions, practice goals, etc. (Do not speak negatively about decisions made, etc.), instead *go speak with your director* after practice.
- * Chewing gum, and wearing jewelry during practice is inappropriate and unacceptable.
- * Wear **RED** lipstick for every performance unless told that you don't have to.
- * ***Keep the Varsity dressing room neat and clean at all times!!!***
- * No eating allowed inside the locker room or dance studio! (Unless given permission by director)
- * Keep all valuables locked up in your locker. (This includes money, jewelry, etc.)
- * **School attendance is very important. You may not miss school, unless it's a medical emergency, death in the family, or absolutely unavoidable!**
- * **NEVER talk back or respond inappropriately.** Be kind and respectful to all, at all times!
- * Only talk positively about our organization and your fellow team-mates.
- * ***Be a role model...set a good example for the Legacies and yourself at all times. Always behave/speak like a lady/gentleman (inside and outside of school). You represent the Royal Legacies!***
- * Follow the rules and regulations at all times! Garland ISD policies, South Garland HS policies, and Royal Legacies expectations.
- * If any problem occurs, go to the Directors or an officer for help and advice immediately.
- * Avoid receiving demerits for anything (inappropriate behavior, forgetting items, arriving late, etc.)
- * ***You must have appropriate and clean "social media" accounts at all times, otherwise consequences will be assigned!***

Royal Legacy Seasons: “A Year in Review”

Team Fitting:

The Director will set a date for “Team Fitting” to help all Legacies get fitted for practice & performance items. The Director will use samples from vendors to complete their order form.

Summer Practices and Camp:

All members must attend all summer practices scheduled by the director. Members are required to attend summer camp where they will bond as a team, get to know each other, but also dedicate time to develop their skills needed for the school year. Football Game-Day preparations, Football Routines, Pep Rally Routines and other material will be learned during summer practices and camp.

Officer/Social Leadership Camp

Two day clinic held for candidates that make a dance officer/social officer position. They will learn additional skills to help them be successful leaders throughout the year.

Class Period:

Royal Legacy class is double blocked for A1 and B6 both semesters. PE and Fine Arts credits will be gained.

Football Season:

The Royal Legacies perform at all Varsity football games, away and home, including playoffs. Football season is mandatory, and members must audition for every halftime performance. The team travels on the GISD provided transportation to all games. Game Day meals are an option (discussed at our Booster Club Meeting). If meals are provided, the team would eat together prior to the game (at the school). Be prepared for at least 1 morning practice at HBJ stadium per football routine; dates will be provided.

Parades/Community Events:

The Royal Legacies participate in 2 parades throughout the year; Labor Day Parade (Sept. 1, 2025) and MLK Parade (Jan. 17, 2026). Members will also participate in community events (during school and afterschool).

Basketball Season:

The Royal Legacies attend to support and perform at most Home Varsity Basketball Games. Dates are determined when the Basketball schedule is provided to the director.

Competition Season:

During contest season all members will learn all team dances and must audition for contest dances. There may be an extra cost associated with contest season that would be due prior to attending contest.

GISD Dance Festival:

At this event all GISD Dance/Drill Teams will showcase various routines. The festival is open to the public for spectators to attend.

Spring Show:

Spring Show is our end of the year drill team production held in the SGHS Auditorium. The dancers will participate in a number of team routines, specialty groups, and student choreographed dances. This is an event to celebrate our team and our year.

End of the Year Awards Ceremony/Banquet:

Dressy casual event to celebrate the year’s accomplishment with Royal Legacies and family members.

Uniform Return:

All members of the Varsity Drill Team will receive clean district uniforms for the school year, and will be required to return all uniform pieces dry-cleaned, or pay an estimated cost of \$40-\$50 for the cleaning fee.

Fundraisers

Fundraisers are held throughout the year to help raise money for team needs. Fundraisers will be discussed in more detail at each Booster Club meeting.

***Royal Legacies is a year-round commitment with a 1-month summer break, plus holiday breaks throughout the school year!**

***We also plan Team Bonding Activities for our team to unite, relax and make fun memories together!**

***Fundraisers benefit the entire team, and will be highly important in order to raise money for the team needs (such as contest season, spring show and end of the year banquet).**
