Asbestos Management Plan

An Asbestos Management Plan (AMP) is a documented strategy designed to manage asbestos-containing materials (ACMs) within a property. It outlines procedures for identifying, monitoring, and controlling asbestos risks to ensure safety for occupants and workers.

Key Components

- Identification of ACMs: The plan includes a detailed inventory of all asbestos materials present in the building.
- Risk Assessment: Evaluates the condition of ACMs and the potential for exposure.
- Management Procedures: Details how to maintain, repair, or remove asbestos safely.
- Monitoring and Review: Establishes protocols for regular inspections and updates to the plan as necessary.

Purpose

The primary goal of an AMP is to prevent unintentional disturbance of asbestos, thereby protecting health and safety during maintenance, renovation, or demolition activities.
