Page 7 on the Chromebook Cart Specifications states storage for up to 40 Chromebooks. On page 13 for the Phase 1 section it states 35 for the Chromebooks per cart. Does the district need to a cart that can hold 35 or 40?

### Response 1:

The cart needs to hold up to 40 devices to accommodate large classroom sizes.

#### Question 2:

Phase 1 speaks to an award to four vendors. That the items must deliver within 20 business days from that award. Does award also mean a purchase order will be issued, from GISD, to the selected vendors or just notice of the award?

## Response 2:

To clarify, Phase 1 will be awarded to three vendors.

Vendors are able to view notice of the board agenda, including recommendations to award, on Friday afternoon prior to scheduled board meetings. A purchase order will be issued on the following day after the board meeting approval.

The approved vendor is expected to deliver Phase 1 items within 20 days of the award.
