

QUESTION	RESPONSE
In addition to the Evaluation Criteria equaling 100 points, there is also 20 points available if we accept credit cards for business purchases. Does that mean there is the potential for 120 points? (pg. 48)	The points referred to are listed under header sections Minimum and General Requirements and total 100. These sections comprise an internal system for marking requirements. With the exception of the Minimum Requirement values being knockouts, the remaining values in these sections are not a component of the evaluation scoring.
On page 48, you ask if we're a small, woman-owned, or minority business and that it is "Required". If we do not fall into one of those classifications does that disqualify us from responding?	A response is required but is not given a weighted value – reference Evaluation Criteria #6
On pg. 52, can you explain what is meant by "Exceptions" on that document?	This should be disregarded as an internal exceptions report that has no bearing on the RFP document or supplier responses.
