

PSAT 8

- Practice for the PSAT/NMSQT
- Identifies students for AP classes

(Oct. 15-18)

PSAT/NMSQT

- 10th grade = Superintendent's Scholars
- 11th grade = National Merit
 Scholarships and recognitions
- Identifies students for AP classes

(Oct. 16)

PSAT 9

- Practice for the PSAT/NMSQT
- Identifies students for AP classes
- 9th grade = Rising Scholars

(Oct. 16)

SAT

- Scholarships
- College admission
- Avoid taking developmental classes

(March 4)

THE PSAT FORMAT

PSAT 8/9

2 sections

- Math
- Evidence-Based Reading and Writing

Total score = 240-1440

- 2 section scores
- Each section worth
 120-720

2 hours, 25 minutes

PSAT/NMSQT

2 sections

- Math
- Evidence-Based
 Reading and Writing

Total score = 320-1520

- 2 section scores
- Each section worth 160-760

2 hours, 45 minutes

No penalty for incorrect answers on either test!

TEST TAKING STRATEGIES

When you sit down to take the test:

- Monitor your time!
- Work at a steady pace!
 - If you can't narrow the answer choices to two, come back to the question later.
 - Focus on the easy and medium-level questions first.

Remember: Your score is calculated based on the number of correct answers not on the level of difficulty of the question, so answer ALL questions! Leave no blanks! Commit! Don't omit!



Typical Accommodations (SPED & 504)

The College Board considers all reasonable requests for accommodations needed by students with **documented disabilities**.

Available accommodations are not limited to those listed.

Examples of typical accommodations include:

Extended time

Computer use for essays

Extra and extended breaks

Reading and seeing accommodations

Four-function calculator


